ENTRIES ON THE DAY: ENTRIES ON THE DAY WILL BE CHARGED AT £14 PER CLASS  
(CASH ONLY).

ADMISSION TO THE GROUND: ONE HORSE BOX PLUS  
DRIVER AND ONE RIDER. OTHER PERSON(S) WILL BE  
CHARGED A GATE FEE OF £15.

HORSE BOXES/TRAILERS PLEASE FOLLOW DESIGNATED SIGNS FOR PARKING.  
NON-HORSE VEHICLES WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.  
PRIVATE VEHICLES TO PARK ON THE CAR PARK.

ROSETTES: TO 6<sup>TH</sup> PLACE IN ALL CLASSES.

PRIZE MONEY: PRIZE MONEY 1<sup>ST</sup> TO 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE (EXCEPT CLASS 6)

## **RULES**

1. Rider's age as of the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024
2. The judge's decision is final. Any confrontation with a judge is strictly forbidden. Competitors and spectators must conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Any use of bad language/behaviour/dishonesty or cruelty which may bring the show into disrepute is unacceptable and the perpetrators will be asked to leave the show ground.
3. All ridden horses and ponies competing must be 4 years and over. All competitors must be of a suitable size and weight for the horse/pony they are riding.
4. The Leek and District Show jumping section reserve the right to amend the schedule.
5. NO RESPONSIBILITY IS ACCEPTED BY LEEK SHOW ORGANISERS FOR ANY ACCIDENT, INJURY OR LOSS OF PROPERTY REGARDLESS OF HOW THIS IS CAUSED. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ALL COMPETITORS CARRY PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE WITH A MINIMUM OF THIRD-PARTY COVER.
6. Under no circumstances must a horse/pony be left unattended unless securely boxed and must not be left tethered in the vicinity of the show ring or tethered to the outside of vehicles.
7. All competitors must be correctly dressed whilst mounted. Hats to British Standards must be worn. Chin straps and jackets must be correctly fastened. Correct footwear must be worn body protectors may be worn.
8. Complaints must be made in writing to the show secretary accompanied by a £20 deposit. Any complaints will be considered at the first available committee meeting and a decision will be notified to those concerned. The deposit will be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld.
9. No unauthorised person(s) is allowed in the ring at any time.
10. All classes to be jumped under British Show Jumping rules.

**Anyone attending the show is asked to place litter in the bins provided or take it home.**

**CHILDREN MUST BE KEPT UNDER ADULT CONTROL. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEAD AND KEPT UNDER CONTROL. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER THEM.**

## **Show Jumping Classes**

### **Class 1a**

Cross poles on the lead rein.

Riders 12 years and under. 1 round against the clock

To run in conjunction with Class 1b (separate prize for lead rein)

**Class 1a sponsor: Sovereign Air Conditioning**

### **Class 1b**

Cross poles off the lead rein.

Riders 16 years and under. 1 round against the clock

To run in conjunction with Class 1a.

**Class 1b sponsor: Carson Powell Construction Ltd.**

### **Class 2**

45cm without fillers

Riders 16 years and under. Jumped as a 2-phase class with jumps 6-12 against the clock.

**Class 2 sponsor: Drayton Beaumont Services (Engineering Consultants)**

### **Class 3**

65cm with fillers

Riders 16 years and under. Jumped as a 2-phase class with jumps 6-12 against the clock.

**Class 3 sponsor: Lawson Motor Company (Used Car Dealership)**

### **Class 4**

75cms with fillers

Riders 16 years and under. Jumped as A4 (1 round against the clock)

**Class 4 sponsor: Kathy-Briand Hall Equine & Human Therapy**

### **Class 5**

80cms – 90cms with fillers

Riders 16 years and under. 2 rounds to include a jump off.

**Class 5 sponsor: Agnew Equine Ltd. (Veterinary Services)**

## **Class 6**

Ride & Run 50 - 60cms (Lead rein entries welcome)

Split class - Separate prizes/rosettes for each category

Category 1 - Riders up to and including 11 years of age

Category 2 – Riders aged 12 to 16 years

First 6 fences to be jumped whilst mounted followed by a short obstacle course to be completed by the rider on foot.

## **Class 7**

60cms with fillers

Riders over 16 years of age. Jumped as a 2-phase class with fences 6-12 against the clock.

**Class 7 sponsor: The Ashes (Wedding Venue)**

## **Class 8**

70cms with fillers

Riders over 16 years of age. Jumped as a 2-phase class with fences 6-12 against the clock.

**Class 8 sponsor: Norman Ferns Removals, Leek**

## **Class 9**

Open 80cms-90cms with fillers.

Riders over 16 years of age. 2 rounds to include a jump off.

**Class 9 sponsor: Proctor's Nurseries (Garden Centre)**

## **Class 10 – The John Carter Memorial Class**

Take your own line (accumulator) maximum height 100cm

Riders over 16 years of age

Each fence is allocated a point score. Jump as many fences as you can, in any order, in 2 minutes with the Joker fence adding an extra 20 points (can only be jumped twice). Any fences knocked down cannot be re-attempted.
